LOCATION:

St. Marcellinus SS is located at the NE corner of Mavis and Courtneypark Drive West (730 Courtneypark Drive West), which is 1 block north of Hwy 401 in Mississauga.

FACILITY:

St. Marcellinus has an 8-lane 400m rubberized track with a steeplechase water jump. Outside the track area are 2 long jump runways, pole vault pit, shotput area, discus circle with a cage and a large open field for javelin. Washroom facilities are located on the east side of the track. **Please DO NOT enter the school.**

OFFICIATING: Please indicate your officiating preference **TIMING:** Electronic timing will be used for all track events. by filling out the form and faxing it to St. Marcellinus 905-564-3202. Attention Dave Ropret . **AWARDS:** 1st Place – Medals, 2nd & 3rd Place – Medals

AGE CLASSIFICATION:

Novice - under age 15 as of January 1st, of the current school year, and in grade 9.
 Junior - under age 16 as of January 1st, of the current school year.
 Senior - under age 20 as of January 1st, of the current school year.

ELIGIBILITY:

This is open to high school athletes only. Athletes must be entered by their school coach and a school coach must be present at all times throughout the meet.

ENTRY FEE:

Individual Events - \$10.00 per event
 Relay Events - \$12.00 per event
Maximum Team Fee - \$500.00 MAX

Please make your **school cheque** (no personal cheques can be accepted) payable to St. Marcellinus SS and bring your cheques the day of the meet. Receipts will be issued upon payment.

There is a cap of 30 entries for all jump events, 24 entries for relays, 24 for each 3000m, 40 entries for 200m and 400m and 48 entries for all other events due to time constraints. Enter Early to avoid disappointment.

Each school may enter a maximum of 3 students per age group per event. Only 2 relay teams per level/gender. Remember to include seed times for all track events for seeding purposes. All competitors can have an enjoyable experience if their times match those they are racing against. Field events do not require a mark. Coaches please check the minimum standards for all field events, found below. All field event competitors will get 3 attempts. The top 6 will get an additional 3 attempts.
